NORWEGIAN MEMBERSHIP IN OCEAN FLEET EXCHANGE GROUP (OFEG)

With reference to the meeting in Amsterdam on 20-21 April 2006, I have pleasure to confirm that the Institute of Marine Research (IMR) and the University of Bergen (UoB) are delighted to join the Ocean Fleet Exchange Group (OFEG), and accepts the terms of reference as laid down in the Tripartite Agreement signed between NERC, IFREMER and BMBF for the mutual cooperation of marine scientific interests and activities, and the signed bilateral agreement "Technical arrangements for the barter exchange of major marine facilities" between NERC, IMR and UoB.

For barter exchange our vessels "G.O. Sars" and "Jan Mayen" will be available at the agreed 7 points exchange valuation, and at 6 points exchange valuation for the "Johan Hjort" and "Håkon Mosby". IMR and UoB will also have available its ROV Aglantha, a seismic system, giant piston corer, towed body with EK 60 (38/120 kHz) including winch with 1400 m fiberoptic cable, and an optical plankton counter (OPC) towed body. These can be added under the heading of Major Marine Equipment where appropriate.
