Workshop Rationale

The pool of moorings expertise in the UK and Europe has become seriously depleted over the last few years owing to the retirement of key personnel. It is essential that steps be taken to train up the next generation of moorings experts, both through practical sessions and the creation of training and reference materials.

Furthermore, mooring success rates continue to cause concern, and active steps need to be taken to understand and mitigate the risks inherent in mooring operations to ensure that there is cost-effective recovery of data.
